Voting is open for positions on the ANS NCSD (for terms commencing from June 2023). Introducing those on the ballot ...

## Site Highlight-2023 ANS Student Conference

The 2023 ANS Student Conference will be held at the University of Tennessee, Knoxville, on April 13-15. The conference is entirely student-planned by a group of about 20 undergraduate and graduate nuclear engineering students. The organizers expect about 500 students and professionals to travel from across the country for this annual event, which is the premier opportunity for rising nuclear engineers to network with their peers and future coworkers.

Over the course of the weekend, there will be a multitude of exciting events for both students and professionals. Some of the highlights include panels featuring exciting names from across the nuclear industry, technical sessions featuring presentations of student research or senior design work, and a career fair featuring over 40 different companies, national labs, and universities.

NCS is being incorporated into the student conference in multiple ways. One of these is through the presentation of a Nuclear Safety workshop, which is being planned by a handful of NCSD members.

The conference technical program also includes a Nuclear Criticality Safety track, which has seen 8 student submissions and around which two technical sessions are currently planned. Two awards are sponsored by NCSD in this track, one each to the best undergraduate and best graduate paper.

The conference organizers would like to thank NCSD for their help in workshop planning, summary review, and donations to the conference for student travel reimbursements and paper awards, and are looking forward to seeing everyone in Knoxville this April!
